Key verse: Jeremiah 29:11 – “For I know the plans I have for you,” says the LORD. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

Other verses: Matt 25:21 (our ambition/goal), The master was full of praise. ‘Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been faithful in handling this small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. *Enter into the joy of your master [or your Lord]!*

Matt 28: 18 -20a (God's big picture for us), Jesus came and told his disciples; “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you.

Matt 28: 20b (God's promise), And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”
