Arrived Freeport Thursday at 10am. Dudley Seide, Director of Reach Out youth ministry brought me to their new building. It's new to them but it does need some TLC. After purchasing materials, we built three walls for the kitchen, one to enlarge the kitchen, one for a food pass-through and one for a food pantry area. We'll finish the wallboard today.

We begin today (Friday) with an interview at the local news station. I'm going to be a star! Then back to work on the building. I have a commode and sink to install. So much for stardom. Then we'll be closing off four exterior windows. That is going to be a big job since the sills are made of concrete. We've got some chiseling to do. Tonight I'm attending a local youth worship service with Pastor Darrell, Ivy King's nephew.

Dudley has said repeatedly that we have no idea how much of a blessing we are being for his ministry. The house was donated to them by the Port Authority. It is in a drug infested area. Three drug houses are within a few blocks of their building. Dudley is so well respected even in this area that the building has not had a single break-in since taking it over and believe me at this point it wouldn't take much to break in. This too will improve.

You and Pr. Giessler are in my prayers as you worship together today. Though we are apart, we worship as one people of God. I'll be with Our Saviors Lutheran Church worshipping our one great God. May his Spirit rest upon all of us!
