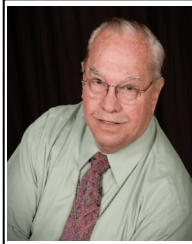

Treasurer's Report for June 2026

Happy June and God's blessings to all.

The Major Roof Fund stands at \$54,632.26 at the end of April.

The Building Maintenance Fund stands at \$8,519.95 for new air conditioners and other upcoming projects.

We were also blessed in April by one of our tenants paying rent through November, which contributed significantly to the positive income for the month. Member contributions were just shy of \$10,000 as reflected below.

As we look ahead, our monthly operating expenses require approximately \$16,000 in offerings to fully meet our budgeted needs. We are grateful for the faithful generosity of our congregation, and we encourage everyone to prayerfully consider whether they may be able to give a little extra when possible. Even small increases in giving can make a meaningful impact when we all share together in supporting the ministry and mission of Peace Lutheran.

Please continue to pray over the finances of Peace Lutheran, that God would guide and provide for our church as we share the love of Christ in our community.

The General Fund account is used for regular expenses (utilities, salaries, insurance, mortgage, etc.)

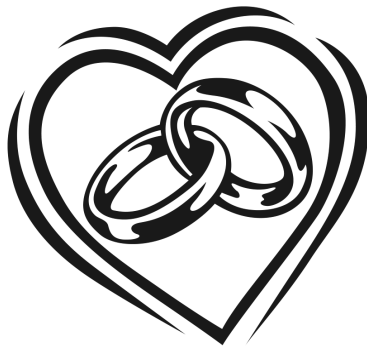
God bless all who give freely of their time, tithes and talents.
